Peace United Church of Christ, in celebration of the 100-year anniversary of its building and organ, challenges its members (and community members) to plant 100 trees.

This is a great way for you to make a community impact by replacing some of the many trees that have died recently. You may purchase trees for planting on your own property or donate the trees to an organization of your choice. **A few organizations the committee has contacted that would like trees include: the city of Elkader (30 trees), Clayton County Conservation Center (35 trees), and the Elkader Country Club (30).**

The church has obtained a grant, which will allow \$25 to be deducted from the cost of the first 100 orders. Additional trees will be charged at the price listed on the order form on the back of this letter. A select variety of trees, approximately 6-7 feet tall, will be purchased from Forrest Keeling Nursery. Taller trees, and a wider variety of trees, will be purchased locally from Keppler Landscaping.

All trees will be available for planting in the spring between March and May, depending on the weather. Limited help will be available for persons wishing to plant trees on their own property but are unable to do so. Please keep requests for help planting trees within or near the vicinity of Elkader. Trees donated to a local organization will be planted by the receiving organization.
